



## 3. Enhancement and Rehabilitation

Target: A minimum of 70,000 trees and shrubs planted annually

**Goal:** Enhance and rehabilitate the natural environment on both public and private lands

- 1. Private land tree planting
- 2. Species at Risk \*NEW\*
- 3. Public land naturalization
- 4. Naturalization of regional properties

## 4. Leadership, Innovation & Knowledge

Targets: Co-ordinate 4 information sharing forums and present at 2 conferences annually, submit three funding applications annually to leverage funding

Goal: Seek and transfer knowledge, demonstrate leadership and innovation in protection and promotion of natural environment.

- 1. Technology/Innovation
- 2. Sharing & dissemination of technical knowledge
- 3. Sustainable communities
- 4. Funding opportunities

## 1. Environmental Land Securement

Target: Pursue a minimum of 6 sites or 65 hectares secured annually

**Goal**: Protect core natural areas and restore linkages

- 1. Natural Environment Land Securement
- 2. Natural Heritage Trail Linkages \*NEW\*
- Agricultural Land natural feature protection \*NEW\*

## 2. Stewardship & Education

Targets: Annually coordinate 60, support 25 and actively participate in 15 partner-led events, outreach to 50,000 people annually through programs and communications

Goal: Educate residents about the value of green infrastructure, provide opportunities to discover connections with nature, and inspire action

- 1. Education programming
- 2. Outreach events
- 3. Public engagement through marketing
