Definitions of terms in columns:

All transactions = Irrespective of country in which donor pays taxes

US = U.S. taxpayer who owns priority conservation land in Canada (Note: citizenship or nationality could be Canadian or any other country)

Cdn donee = any entity qualified under Canadian law (e.g. land trusts, government agencies)

EGP recipient = an entity approved by Environment and Climate Change Canada to receive Ecological Gifts

FMV = Fair Market Value as determined by a qualified appraiser doing a valuation that meets CRA and/or IRS requirements

AF (prescribed donee) = American Friends of Canadian Land Trusts (or one of the other two prescribed donees)

AF Grantee = Entity qualified to receive land interests from AF and is involved in a collaborative donation in which AF will be the actual Donee

CRA = Canada Revenue Agency

IRS = US Internal Revenue Service

EGP = Ecological Gifts Program
