OLTA Land Trust Membership

An OLTA Land Trust Member is:

- A non-profit, charitable corporation with principal objects being the protection and conservation of natural and cultural heritage in the Province of Ontario.
- Organization has passed a board resolution to accept the Canadian Land Trust Standards and Practices as guidelines for operations of the organization, commits to making continual progress toward implementation of the Standards and Practices and agrees to participate in learning as part of its ongoing commitment to OLTA membership and the Standards and Practices.

- * Fees are based on your organization's operating expenses in your last (i.e. most recently completed) fiscal year. Note that operating expenses include all expenditures except capital expenditures for land acquisition and grants for project work not related to staff and overhead costs.



OLTA Associate

An OLTA Associate is

- A non-profit corporation, which has in its objects the protection and conservation of natural and cultural heritage areas. This group includes conservation authorities, national land trusts and municipalities.
- Associate charities are encouraged, but not obliged, to adopt the Canadian Land Trust Standards and Practices as the technical and ethical guidelines for their organizations land securement and stewardship activities.

Emerging Land Trust Associate

- This category is available to organizations working towards becoming a land trust or a new land trust that has had charitable status for three years or less.
- Benefits are reduced rates for workshops and other training, plus access to land conservation networks and access to our community of land trust experts.

Land Steward

- This category is available to not-for-profits who work with lands and nature and would like to benefit from connecting more closely with the land trust community, but are not a land trust.
- Benefits are reduced rates for workshops and other training, plus access to land conservation networks.
